

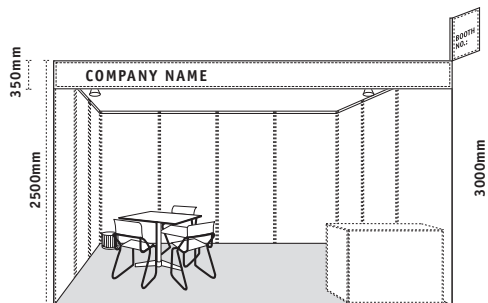

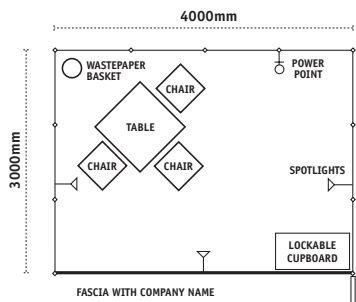

## Indonesia - an emerging global powerhouse in Asia

- GDP growth of 5.9% in 2010 and with projected growths of 6% in 2011, 6.4% in 2012, before expanding by 6.3% a year on an average in 2013 – 15.
- 4th most populous nation in the world with over 240 million inhabitants. Domestic consumption is one of the major driving forces behind the country's economic growth.
- Increasing foreign investment has become a big boon for many Indonesian firms. Indonesia's investment coordinating body BKPM, is hoping to attract US\$30 to US\$40 billion in annual foreign investment by 2015.



### Burgeoning plastics industry

- The plastics industry is enjoying 6% growth in the last 5 years and is projected to maintain the same average growth rate until 2015. The bottling industry, plastic for the agro industry, automotive and building and construction are some of the major driving forces contributing to this growth.
- The Indonesian food processing industry valued at approximately US\$42 billion offers significant market opportunities for the plastic industry particularly in the areas of plastic packaging.
